WHAT IS E-GIVING?

E-Giving is short for electronic giving. It is an easy and secure way to contribute your tithes and offerings to God.

OPTIONS FOR E-GIVING:

1. Watts Chapel Website
2. Payroll Deduction
3. Online Banking through your checking account

In keeping with Biblical principles, we do not want individuals to incur debt in order to give. We are providing E-Giving capability simply as a convenience option.

1. WATTS CHAPEL WEBSITE AT

www.WattsChapel.org

Step 1: From the menu on the home page, click “E-GIVING.”

Step 2: Once on the “online donation” screen, select “Visitor Type” of either “Member” or “Visitor”.

Step 3: Enter your membership number, if you know it.

Step 4: Enter an amount in the provided offering options. Once done click the “add” button for each amount you entered.

Step 5: If there are special offerings not listed (e.g. Vacation Bible School), you may enter the name of the offering and an amount of the offering in “Other 1” and/or “Other 2.” Don’t forget to click the “add” button for each amount entered.

Step 6: Once the above instructions have been completed click the “Donate” button and a pop-up screen will then appear with your total offering amount. If the amount is correct, click “OK.” However, if it is not correct, please click the “Cancel” button. This will allow you to return to the “Online Donation” page, in which you will then be allowed to make any necessary corrections.

PayPal is the service handling Watts Chapel website E-Giving. You can use your existing PayPal account or supply PayPal with your credit card or bank account number for the transaction.

2. **PAYROLL DEDUCTION** is another way to establish regular electronic giving by coordinating electronic fund transfers through your employer. You must contact your personnel department to have funds electronically transferred to Watts Chapel each pay period. Please contact the Finance Office for the information you will need to provide your employer to complete the process. Your employer will need the church bank account number to be credited and Watts Chapel needs your membership number as a reference point for the transaction. This information will be provided to you by the Finance office.

3. **ONLINE BANKING** is available through your financial institution. Most Banks and credit unions offer a way to pay bills online. This is another efficient and cost effective way to transmit funds to Watts Chapel. A check is mailed to Watts Chapel by your banking institution and will be counted in the next Sunday offering after your check is received. You can set your contributions to coordinate with your pay period on a weekly, monthly or bimonthly basis. Contributions can be set to recur automatically each month with online banking.
